- 3) The applicant has participated in extracurricular activities and community service activities while enrolled as a student at Russellville High School.

Application Procedure:

- 1) Applicants must complete the attached application package and mail to the following address no later than April 18, 2019: (NO POSTMARKS ACCEPTED)**

- 2) Applicants must attach one letter of recommendation with the application. The letter must come from an individual you see as a community leader in Russellville.**
- 3) Applicants must include the activity sheet, essay sheet, and question sheet provided with the application.**
- 4) Applications must include the student's transcript covering high school years to date.**

Amount of Scholarship:

The scholarship is a \$2000 scholarship with \$500 being paid each semester. At the end of each semester, the student must present his/her official transcript and if funding is available, the scholarship may be renewed based on the student being enrolled as a full-time student with a minimum grade point average of 2.75 and the scholarship committee's recommendation.

Applications will be made available through the Russellville High School guidance office.
